Audition Info:

- We have **3 Teams: Intermediate 3/4 & 5/6 and Advanced Dance 7/8**
- Auditions are only for these 3 levels.
- **Beginning Dance** is NOT guaranteed nor do you audition for it. Beginning Dance is a PE and you may request it with your counselor when selecting your classes. We have no control over who is placed into those classes - only team classes.
- Auditions will be held April 18th & 19th in the Millikan Dance Rooms
- Audition Time: 4-6:30pm both days. If you are cut the first day you do not return the second day.
- **Technical Skills** we are looking for are noted in the Audition Packet.
- **Improv** -You will be doing improv where you will showcase your impromptu knowledge of of Contemporary & Jazz technical skills. DO NOT come with a choreographed "improv", we can tell. This is to be 100% off the cuff.
- **Dress Professionally** with your attire, hair and makeup.
- **First day of Auditions: Improv and technique.** After we do improv and technique dancers will either 1. be released or 2. asked to stay for choreography. If you are released you do not come back for Day 2.
- **Choreography** will be uploaded to the Millikan Dance website under the 23/24 Audition Tab.
- **Second Day:** Same as day 1 with the addition of combo and groupings with like skilled level dancers.
